Meeting was called to order by M. Hayashida, acting chairman

ROLL CALL

Present: Council members and Block Representatives

R. Kako made a motion, seconded by Mr. Nishimura, that an executive committee of the body be elected before proceeding with the meeting. The motion was approved and carried.

Election was held by secret ballot; and those elected were:

Chairman: Minejiro Hayashida
Vice Chairman: Shintaro Miyazaki

Motion was made by F. Inoshita, seconded by T. Asano, that the Chairman appoint the executive secretary. The motion was passed. The Chairman appointed Shigeichi Kawano to serve as Executive Secretary.

It was agreed that the body shall adopt the title of: "The Study Committee For The Opening Of The West Coast."

Block Reports

Each representative reported the reactions and opinions of the people of his block in regard to the reopening of the West Coast and the eventual closing of the centers.

Vacancies

I. Itani made a motion, seconded by R. Kako, that blocks without representatives to the Study Committee be notified to fill vacancies. The motion was unanimously passed.

Hugo Wolters' Statement

Motion was made by S. Donao, seconded by K. Hoshizaki, that mimeographed copies of the statement by Hugo Wolters, head of the WRA liaison section, already translated into Japanese in the "Rowher Outpost" be printed and distributed to the Study Committee members for better understanding of the issues. The motion was approved and carried.

It was decided that the next meeting of the Study Committee be held Thursday, December 7,

The meeting was adjourned 4:35 p.m.
