gathered D 1670. The
first Minister W^m Sam^l
Street. ^{two years after W^m Stiles died?}
Died about 1722 At 87
W^m Whittelsey ordained
1710 - died 1752 At 67
W^m Dana ordained 1758.
Wallingford pple went from
New Haven

Stamford pple went from
Wethersfield

Wallingford Meel 16852
Pres^l D^r Gap judge pple at
W^m Waterman's Ord^r eno^d to
fill 4 times as much ground
as the Meel House or about
4000. W^m Waterman was aged
20 then

Coping from New Haven
to N^o H. I overtook a farming
I saw - & entering into some
Talk with her she told me
there now were but three
men & few married Women
Indians in Farmington. I
asked who was their Sachem.
She said W^m Pitkin was their

Sain be accented short & not

say, the Ord^r pple stood in
a circle around the Stage
which could not exceed seven
Rods diam^r or six & half Rods.
The highway is measured 9 1/2
Rods & there was a Wood pile
& Cart room between the pple
& the fence. The Ordination
of W^m Waterman over the Chh
of the minor part at Wallingford
Oct. 1761.
