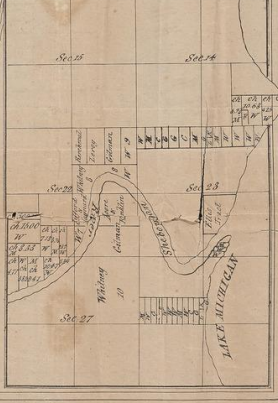
SHEBOYGAN.

The Town of SHEBOYGAN situated at the mouth of Sheboygan River on the West Side of Lake Michigan about 50 Miles north of Milwaukee and 64 miles south of Green Bay, and 33 miles due east from the Town of Fond du Lac at the head of Lake Winnebago. The Sheboygan River is a large Stream and is capable of being made the best Harbor on Lake Michigan. The Town and adjoining country is settling very rapidly by Eastern Farmers and Mechanics. Persons by referring to the map of the Territory of Wisconsin will perceive at once the great advantages it has over almost any other point, West of Lake Michigan.
