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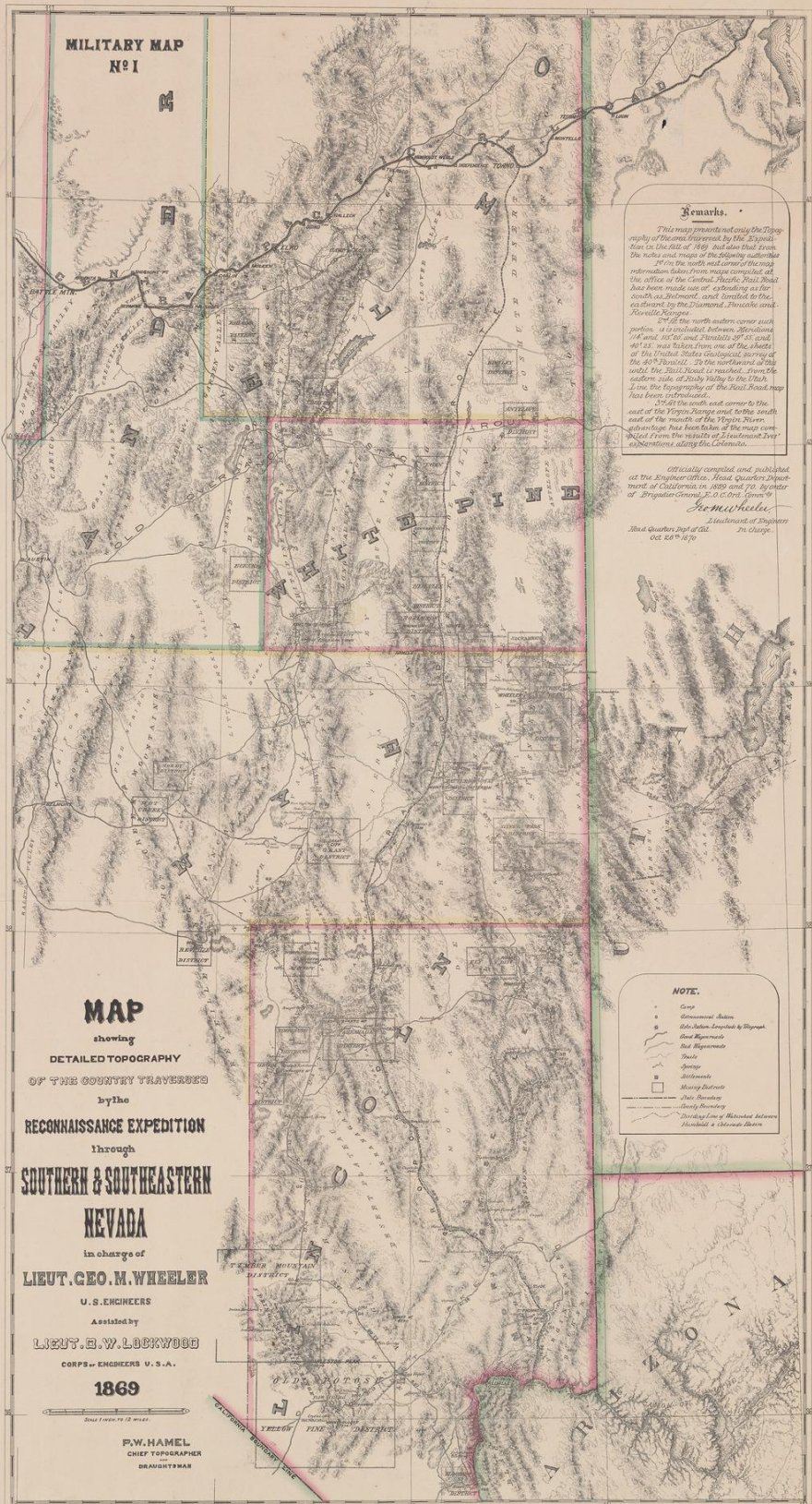

**Remarks.**

This map presents only the Topography of the area traversed by the Expedition in the fall of 1869 and also that from the notes and maps of the preceding expeditions. From the north west corner of the map information taken from maps compiled at the office of the Central Pacific Railroad has been made use of extending as far south as Bolinas, and limited to the eastward by the Diamond, Nevada and Nevada Ranges.

In the north western corner such portion as is included between meridians 114 and 115° W and parallels 39° 55' and 41° 15' was taken from one of the sheets of the United States Geological Survey of the 40° Parallel. To the westward of this until the Bull Head is reached, from the eastern side of Lady Mary to the Utah. In the topography of the Bull Head top has been introduced.

In the south east corner to the east of the Virgin Range and to the south east of the mouth of the Virgin River information has been taken of the map compiled from the results of Lieutenant Dyer's explorations along the Colorado.
