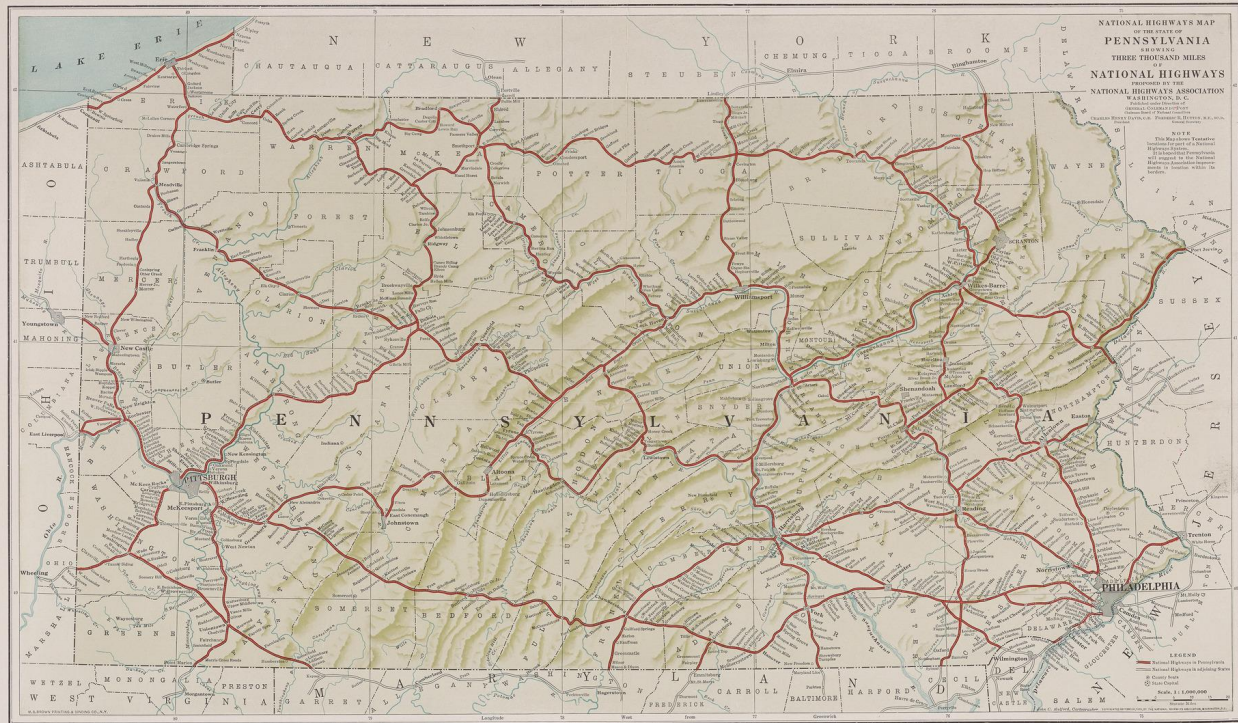

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Population of PENNSYLVANIA, 7,665,111 or 18% of the total, distributed among 47 counties, or 18% of the total.
Contiguous population served, 7,579,265 or 9% of the total, located in 43 traversed counties, or 92% of the total.
Adjoining population served, 88,845 or 1% of the total, located in 5 adjoining counties, or 7% of the total.
Total population served, 7,668,111 or 18% of the total, located in 47 counties, or 100% of the total.
Mileage of Public Roads in Pennsylvania 47,265. Mileage of Proposed National Highways 3,000, or 6.3% of the total.
Therefore 3.43% in National Highways will serve in traversed and adjoining counties 100% of the people in the State.
Similar maps of other States are being prepared by the Association, and will be issued as rapidly as possible.

These National Highways will also act as State Highways and as County Roads and Town or Township Roads, for the facilities through which they pass. Their building and maintenance by the National Government will thus relieve the State, the County, and the Town or Township of the cost of building and maintaining these trunk highways and give each and every one of them one, two, three or more principal highways, as the case may be, built and maintained free of expense to the local community. The funds of the State, the County, and the Town or Township can therefore be used for their other and secondary roads less costly to build and maintain.

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
