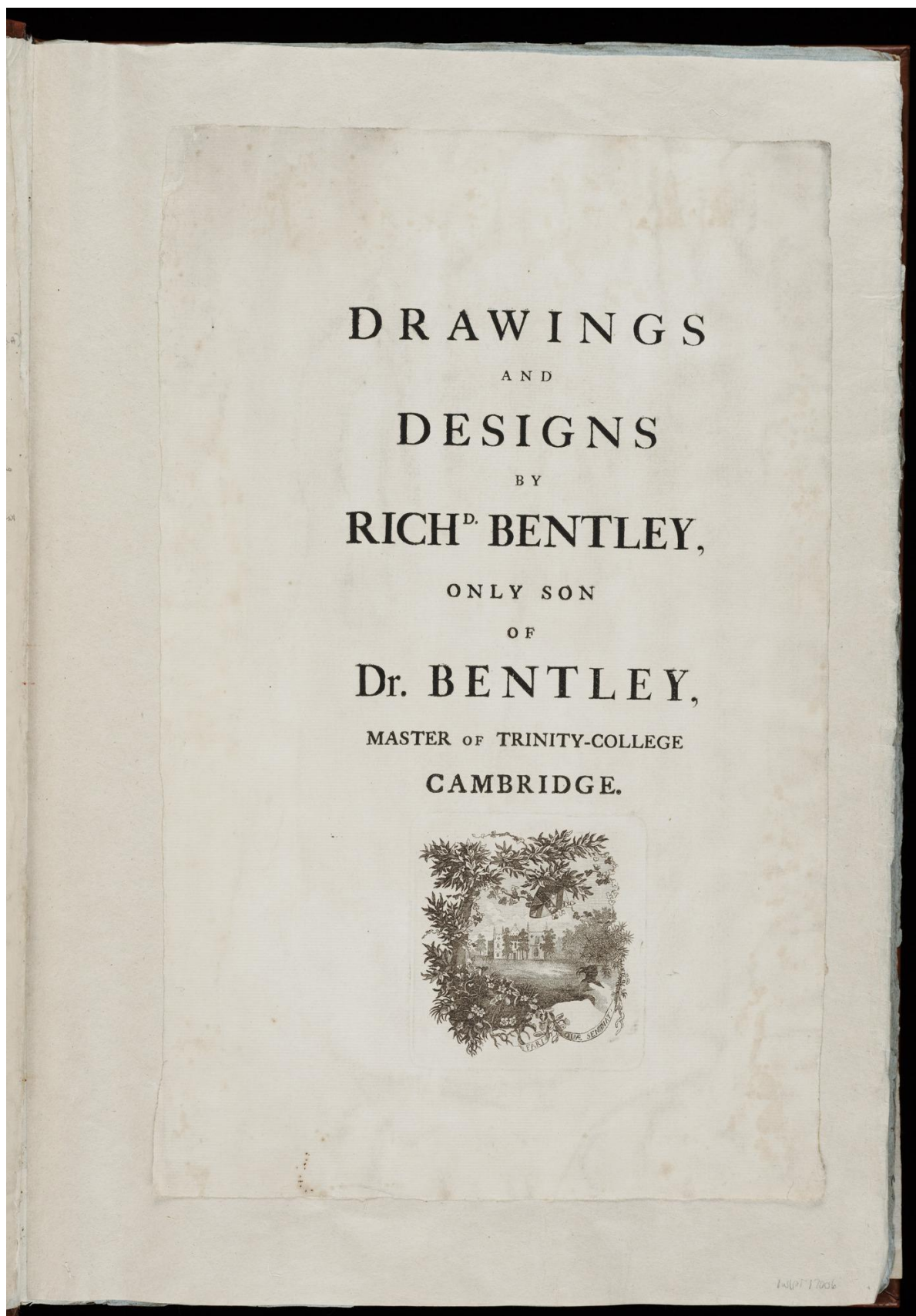

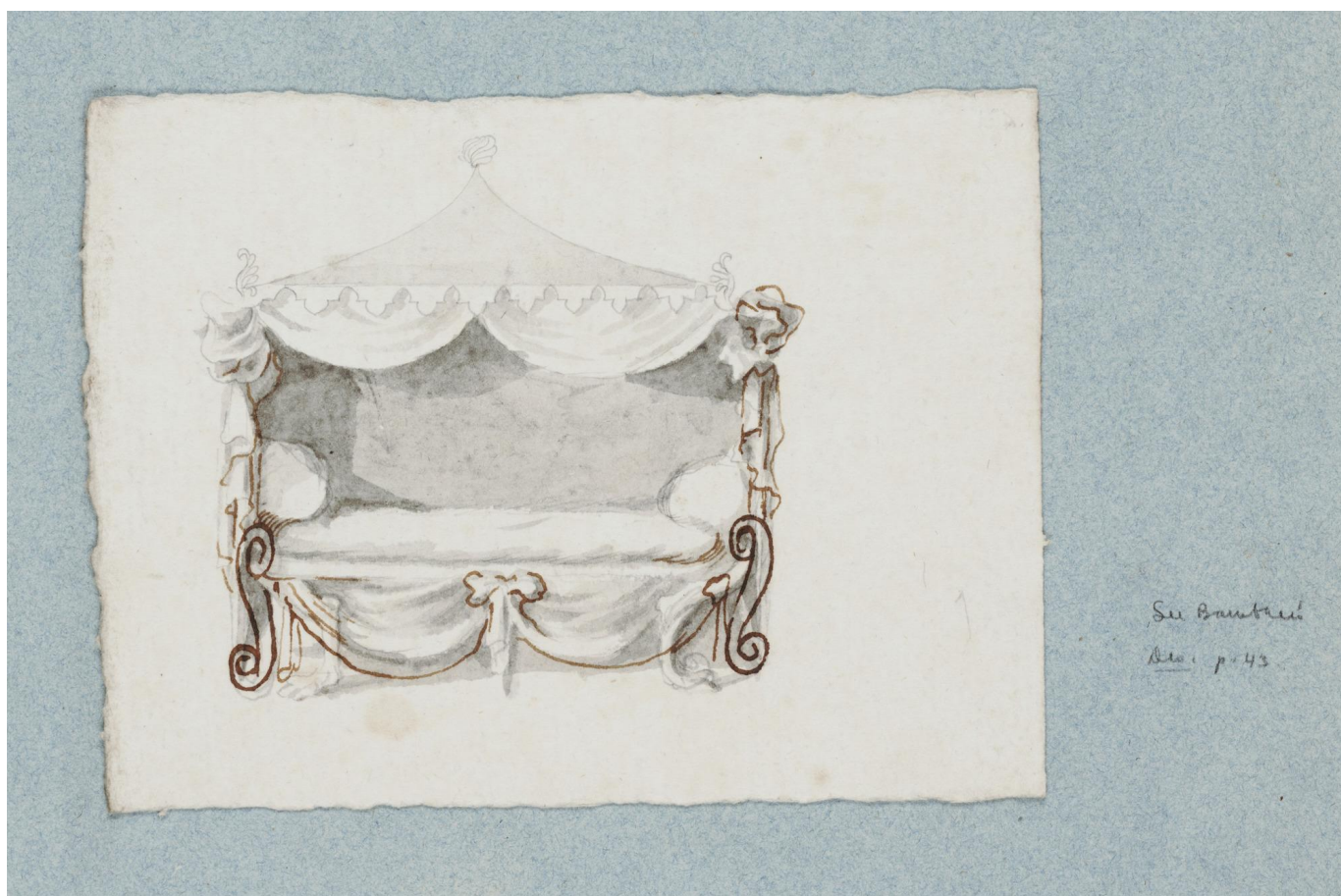

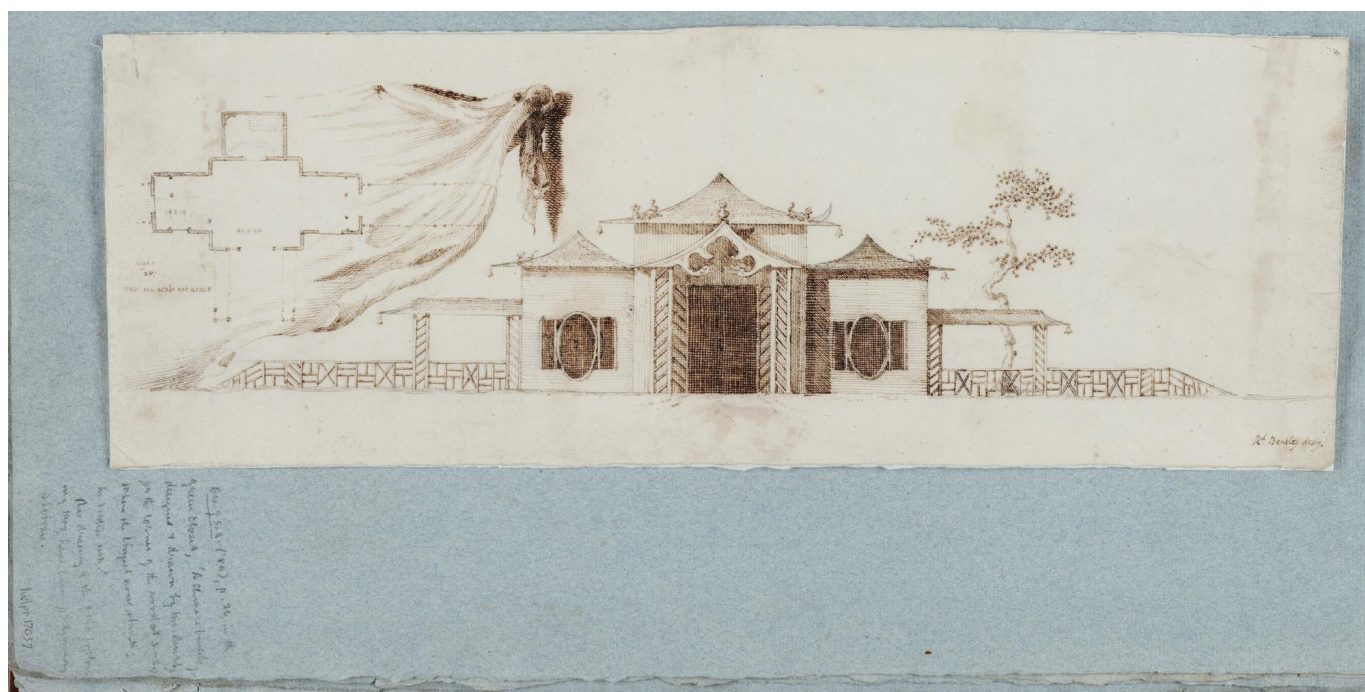

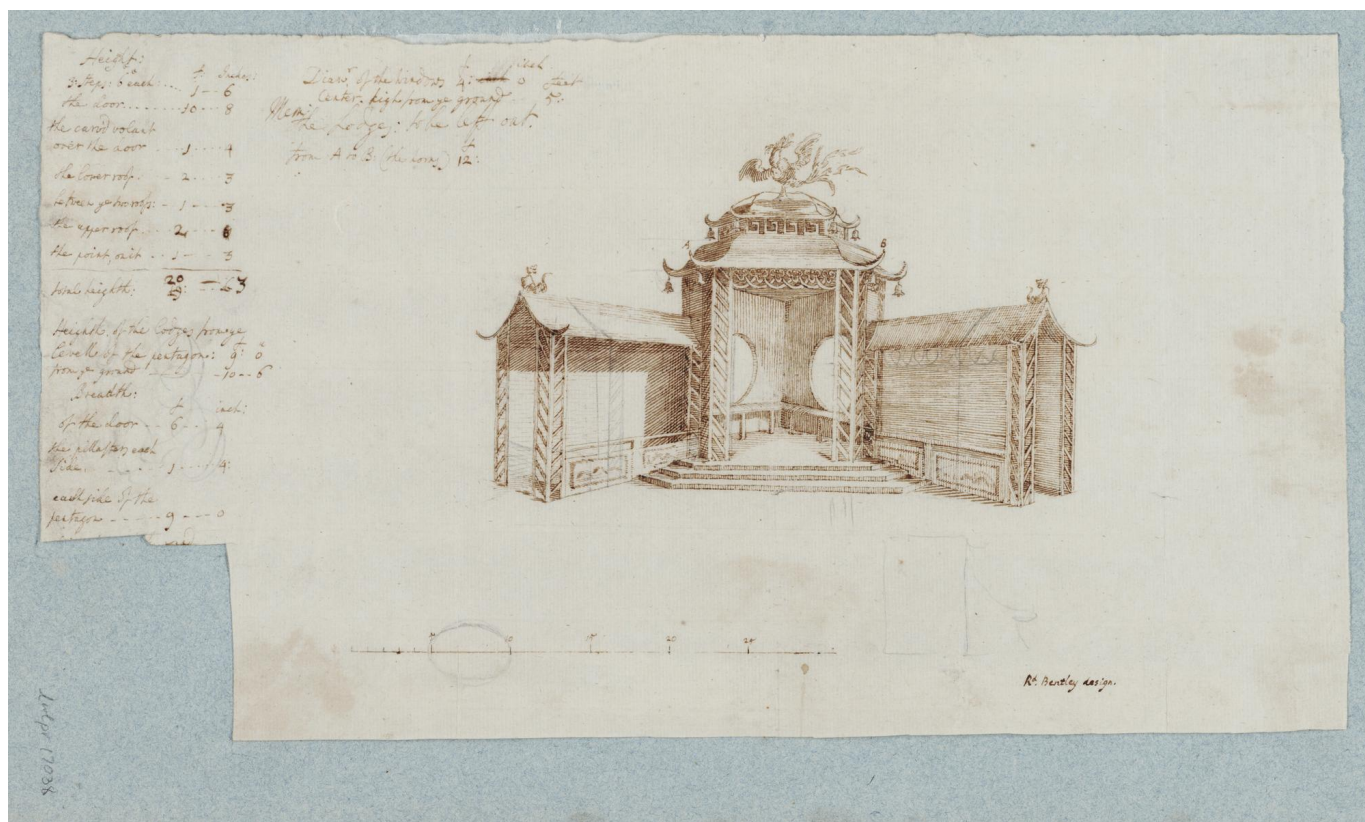
Caption: [Elevation for a Gothic entrance of three bays, with rose window] [art original] / Rd. Bentley.

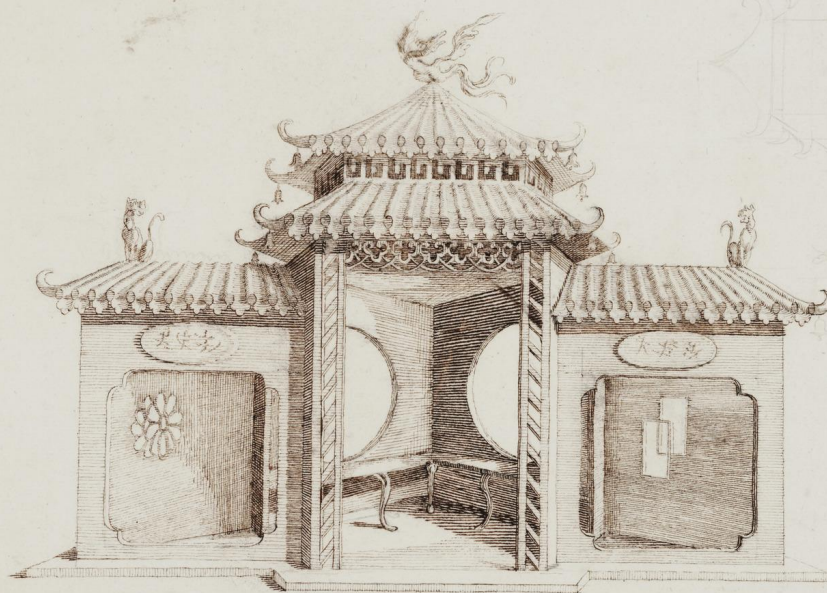
Caption: [Elevation of a Chinese tea-house] [art original] / Rd. Bentley desig.

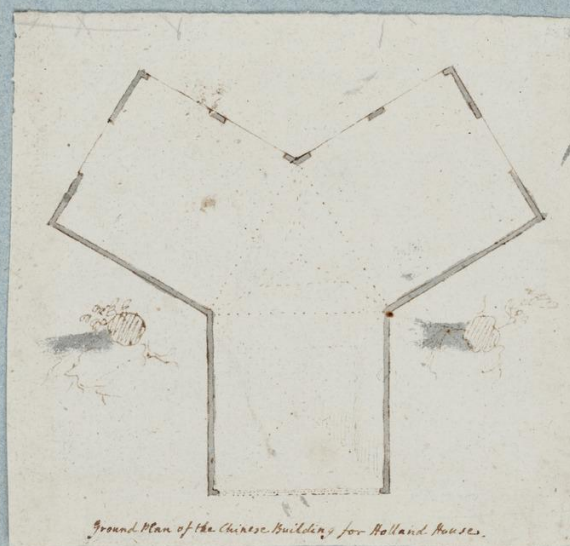
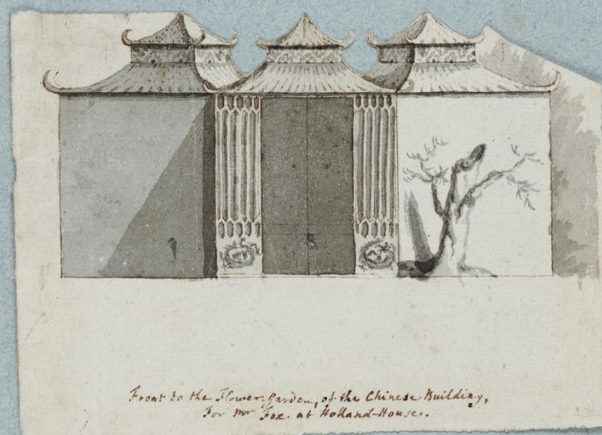

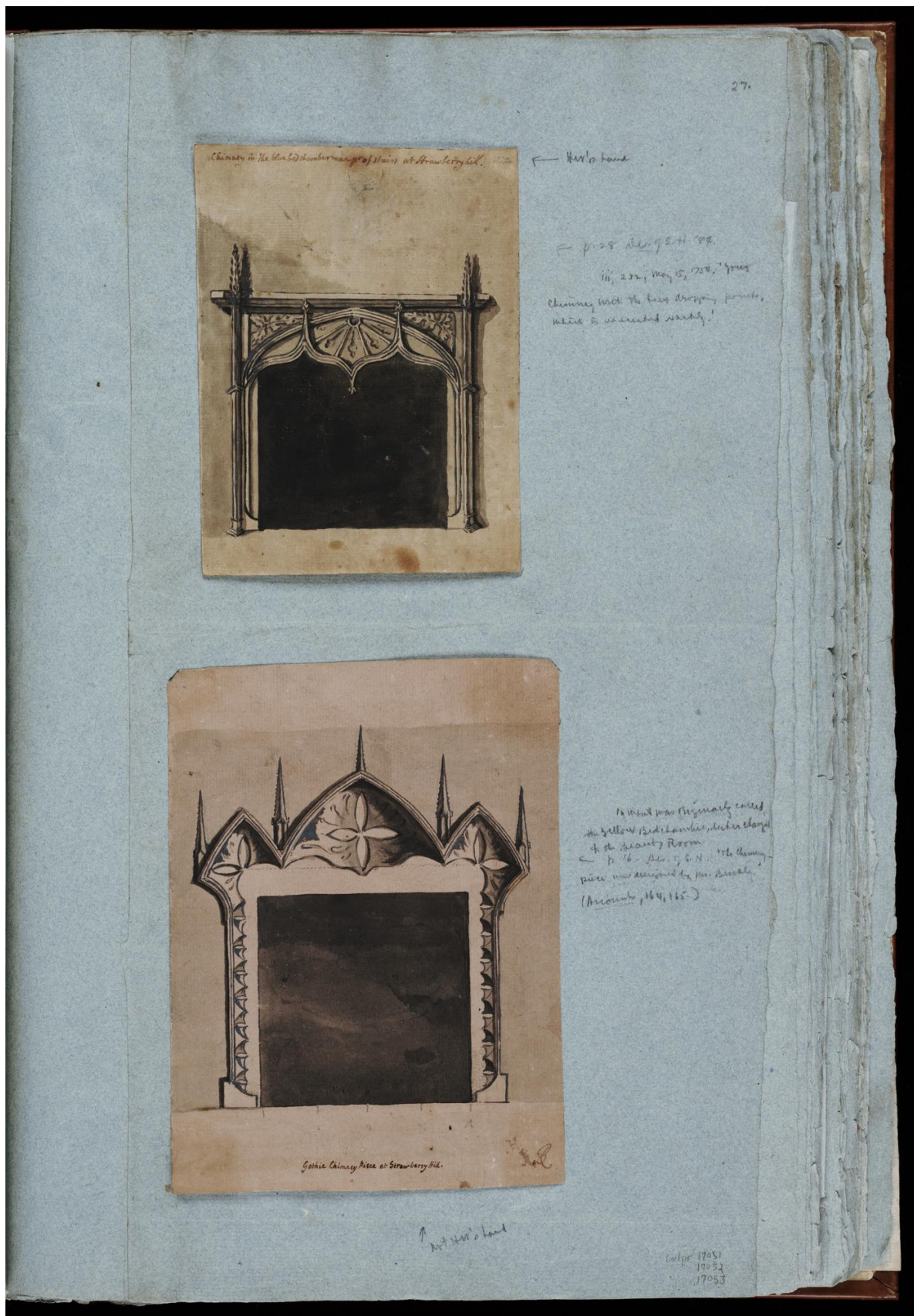


Caption: [Design for a Gothic chimney-piece] [art original].

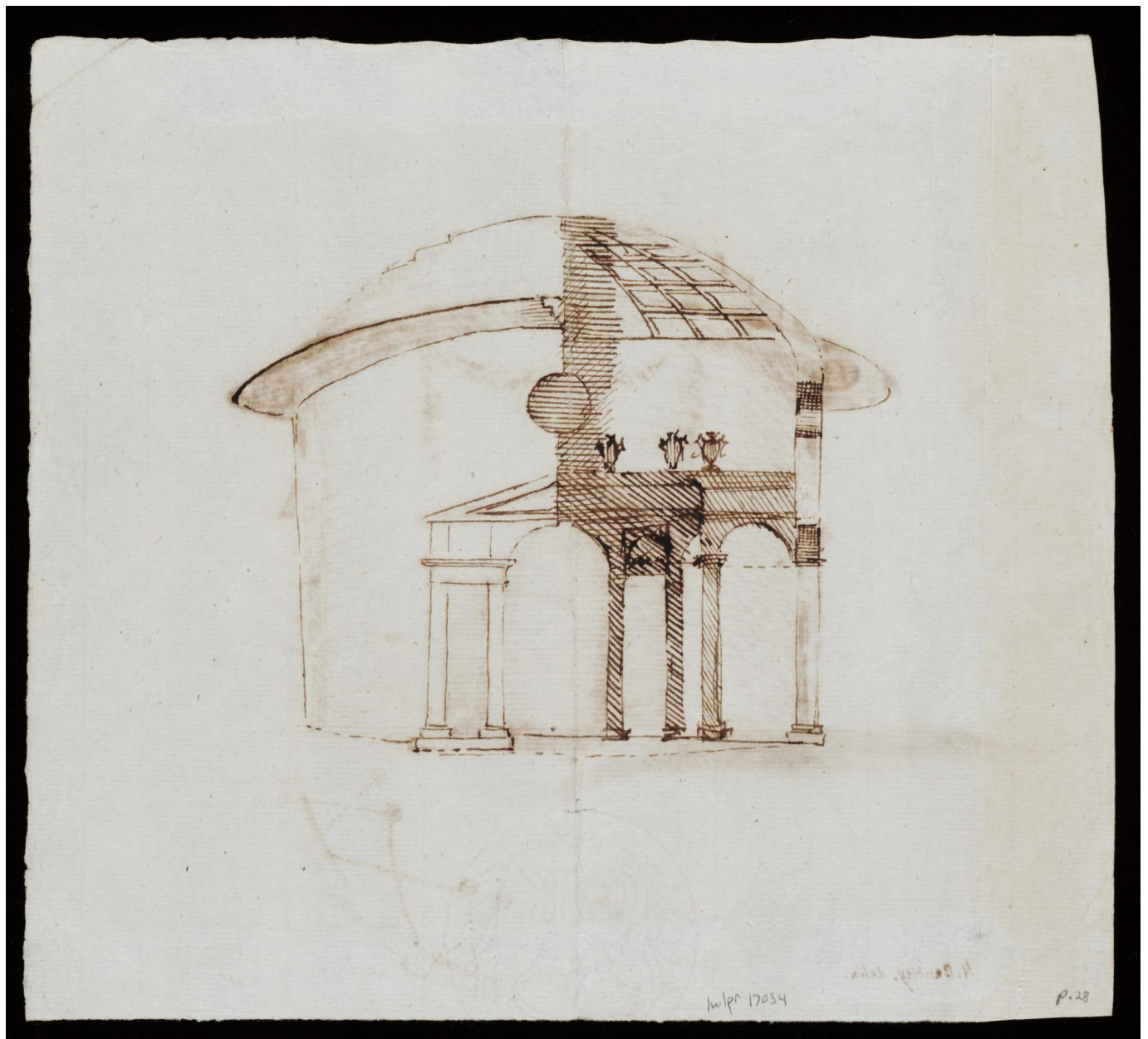

To Montagu, June 11, 1753, (iii, 164): 'I have filled Mr. Bentley's Gothic Lanthorn with painted glass, which casts the most wonderful glow on the stairs that ever was seen since the days of Babylon. 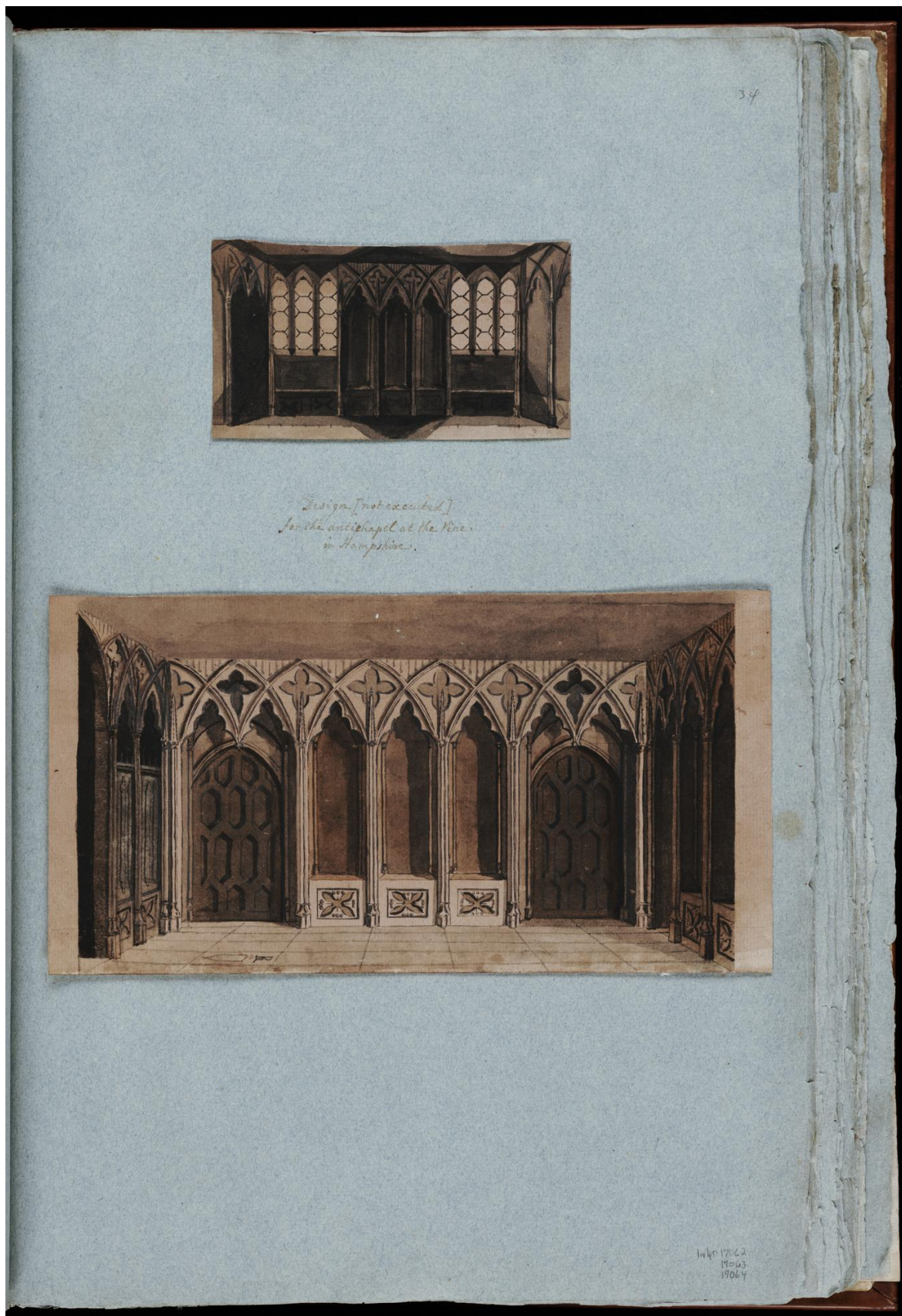

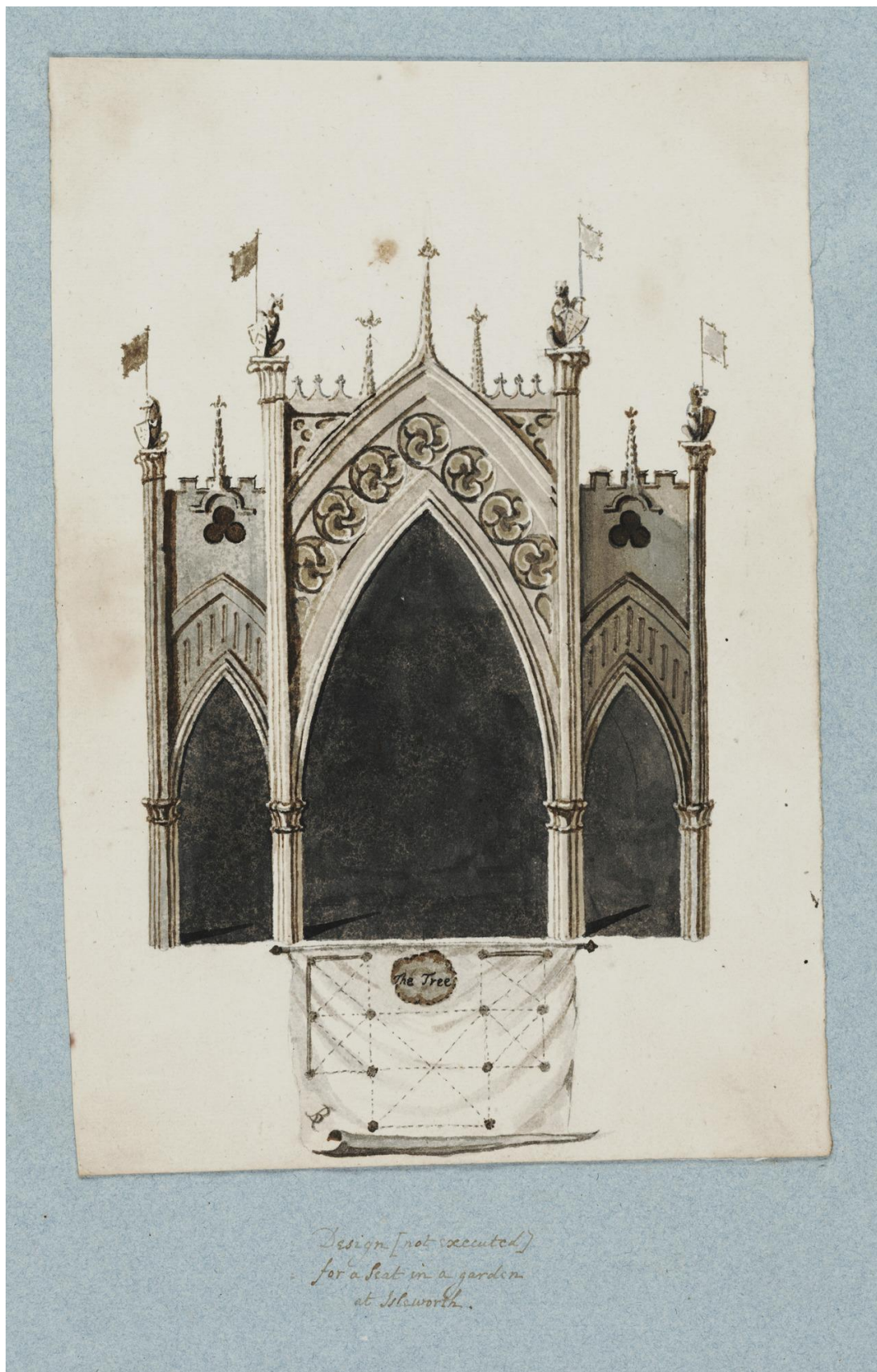


Caption: Design (not executed) for the antichapel at the Vine [sic] in Hampshire [art original].

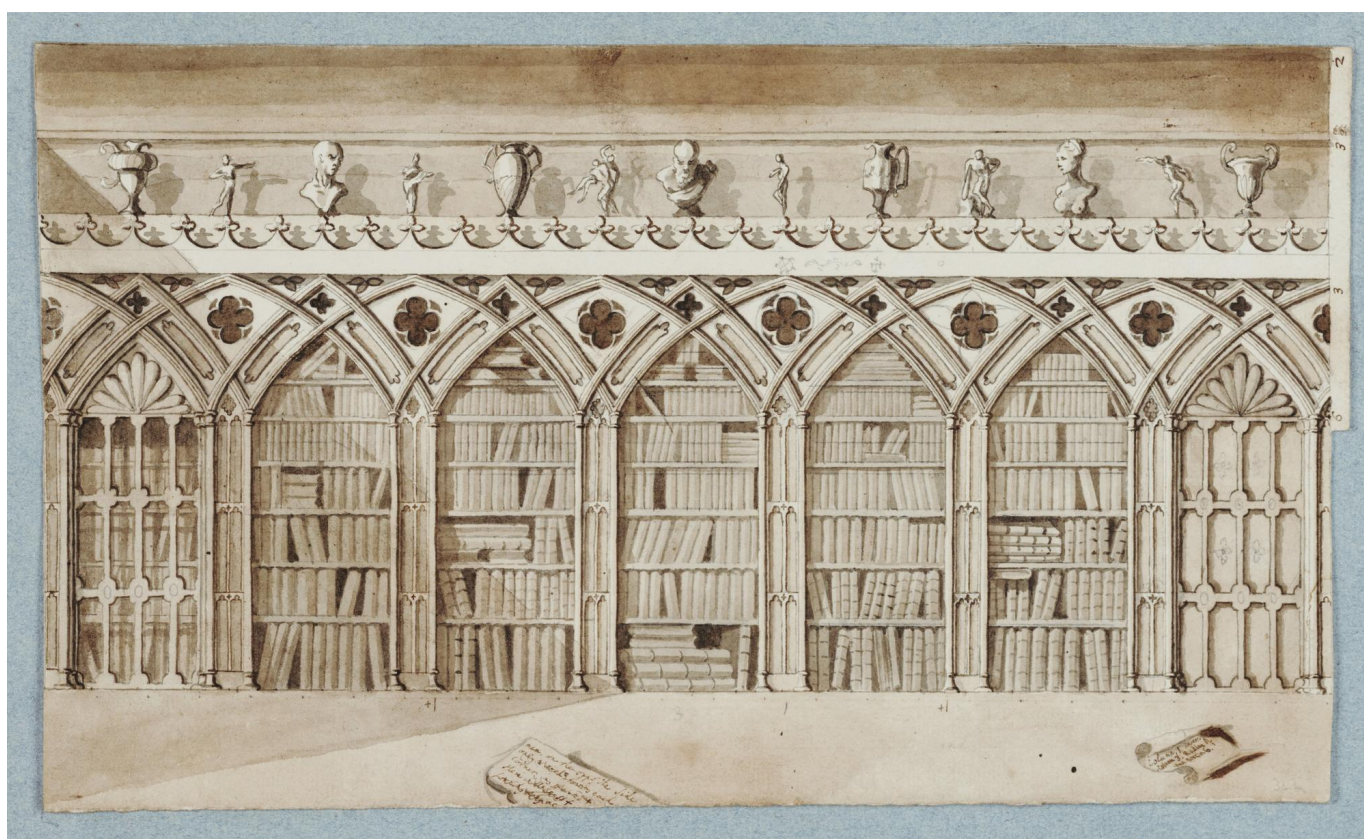


Caption: Design (not executed) for a seat in a garden at Isleworth [art original] / RB.

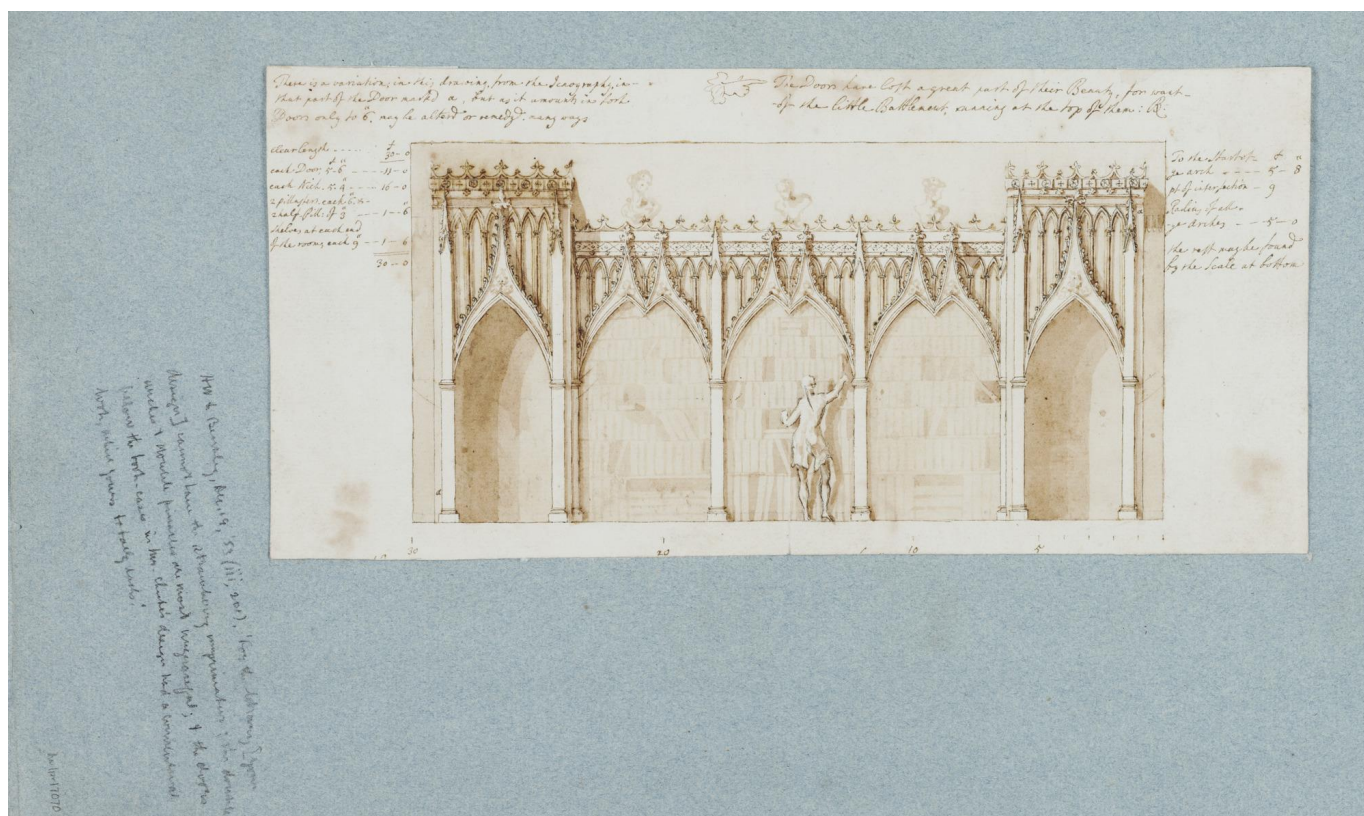

To Ld. Strafford, July 4, 1757. (IV, 70) 'I hoped to have a few lines from Progeny and
 you towards building Mr. Bentley's design. . . . Thank God, the happiness of the menagerie does not
 depend upon administrative machines, etc.

To Geo. Montagu, Sept. 1, 1760. (IV, 127.) 'Lord Strafford has checked the little gothic building
 which I got Mr. Bentley to draw; I took the idea from Chichester Cross.'

To the Bury's, Sept. 4, 1759, (XIV, 243) 'and pray like the little gothic edifice, & its position in the men-
 agerie! your husband recommended it, & had it drawn by Mr. Bentley, from Chichester Cross.

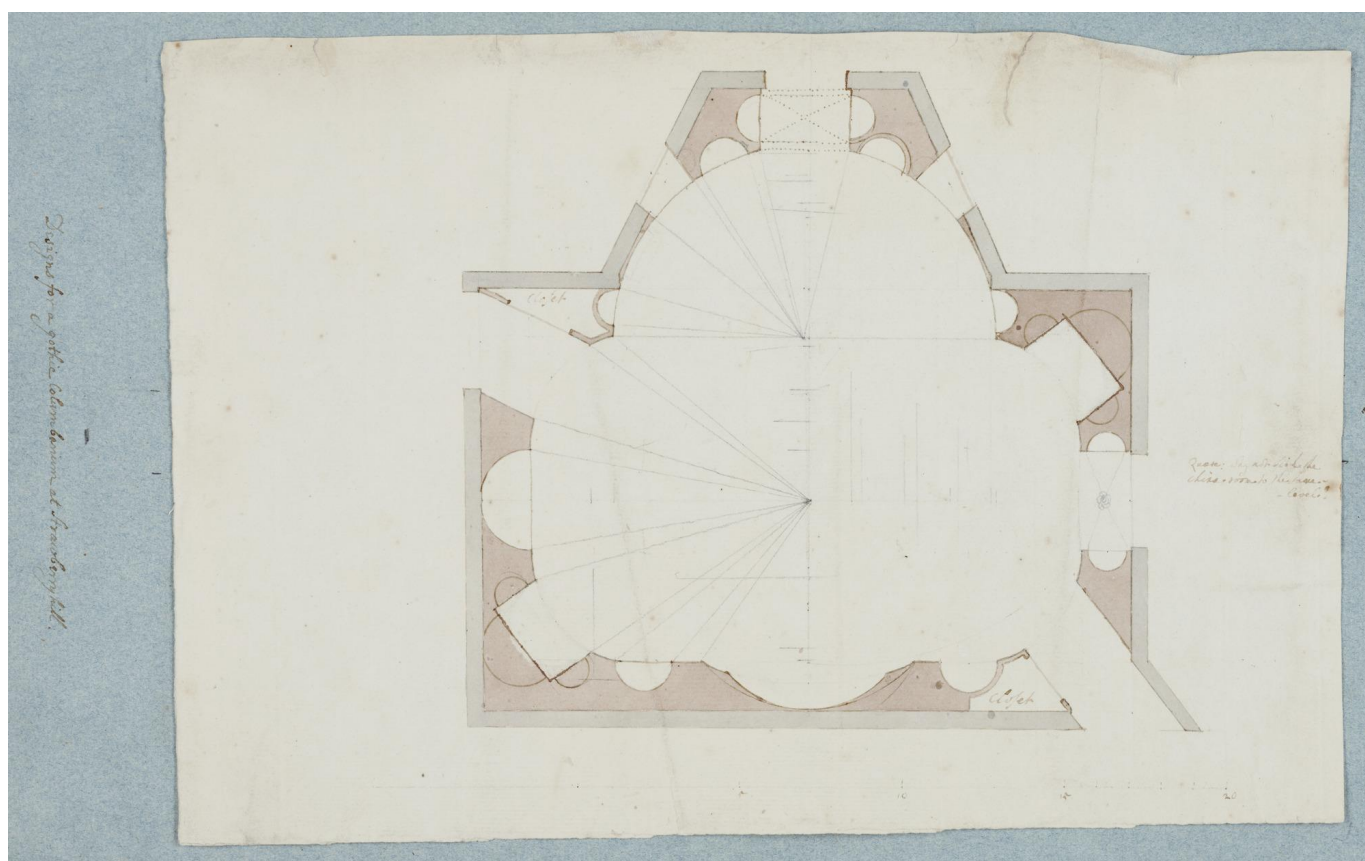
Caption: Design (not executed) of a Gothic columbarium at the Vine [sic]. East end [art original].

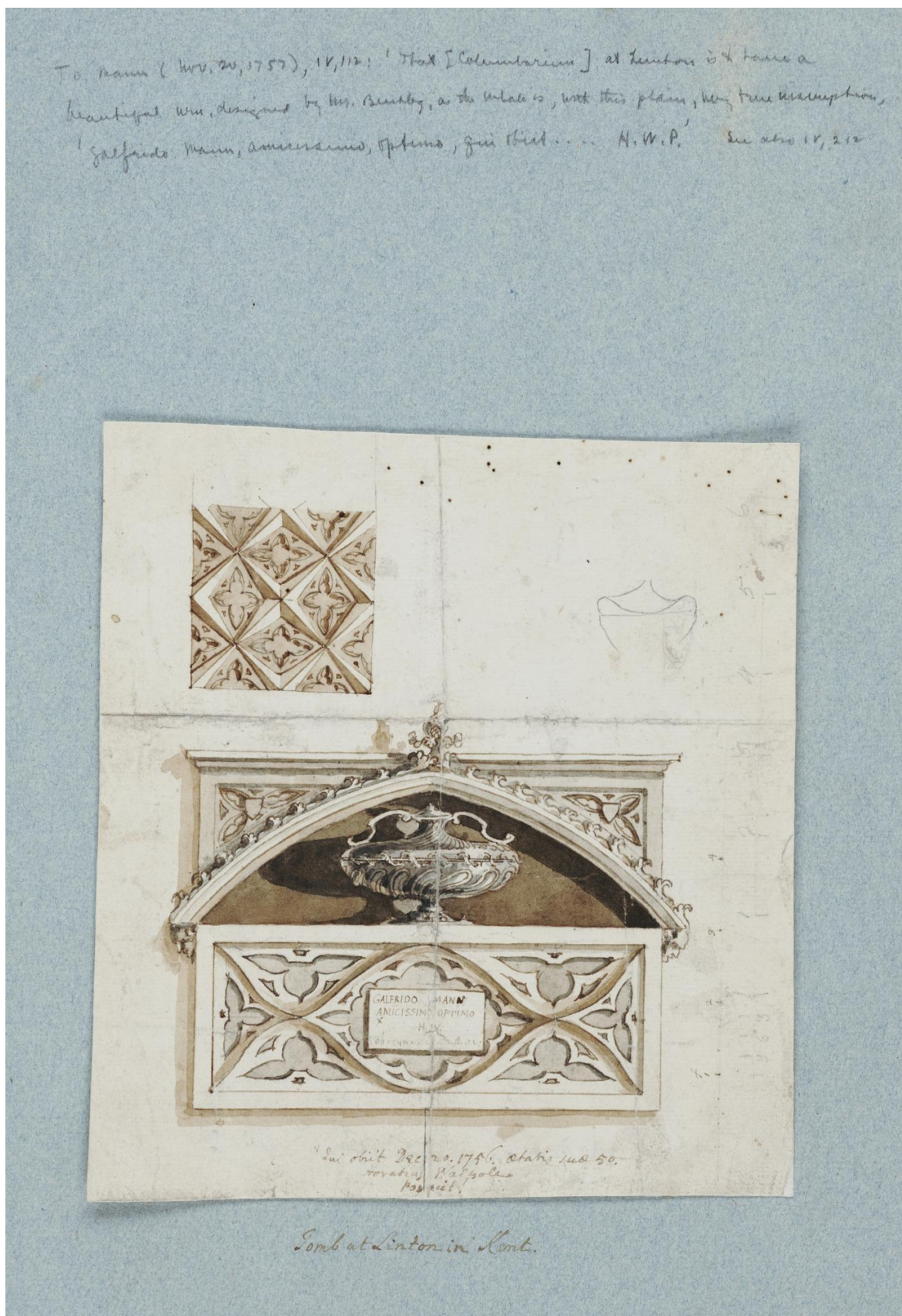

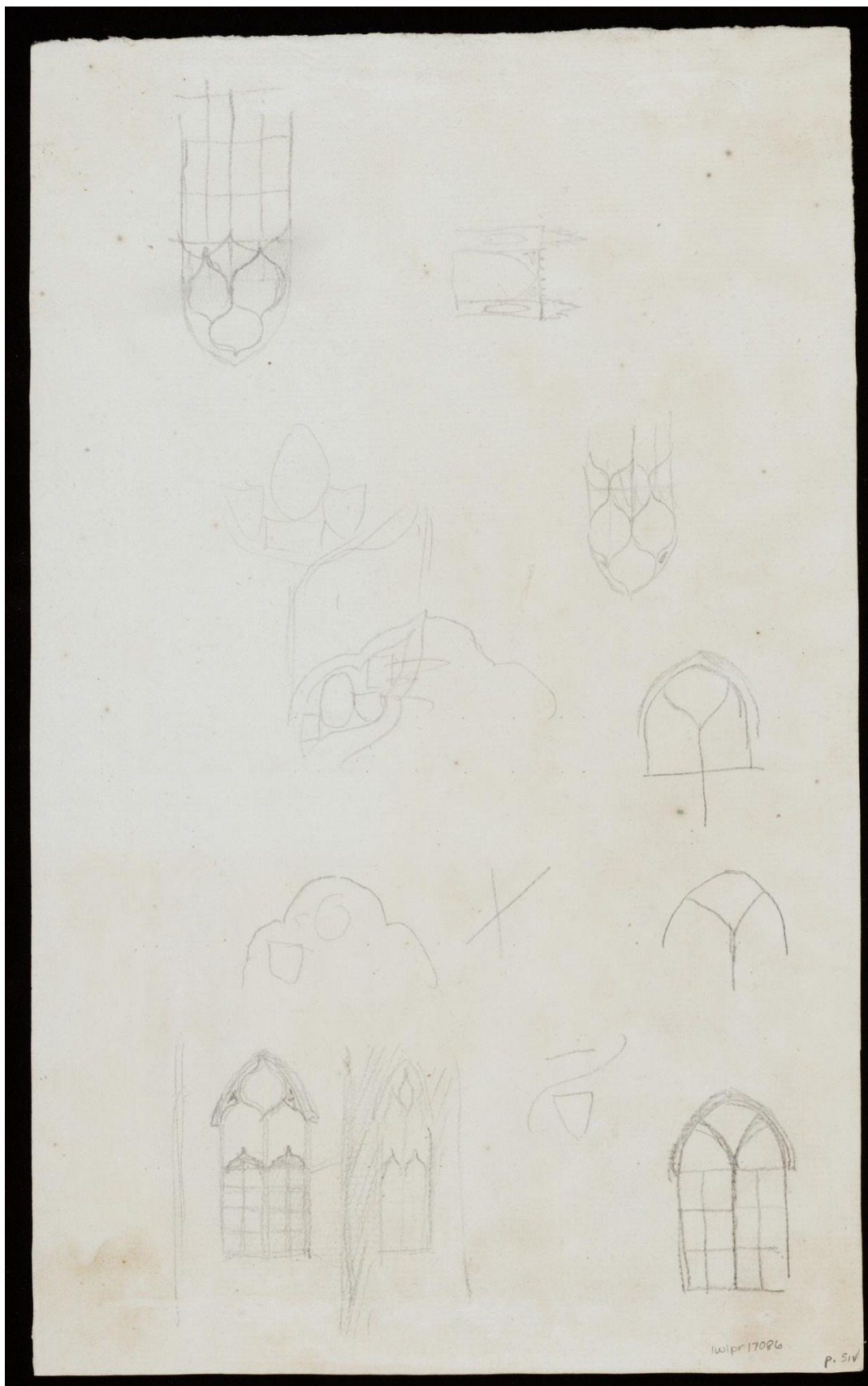

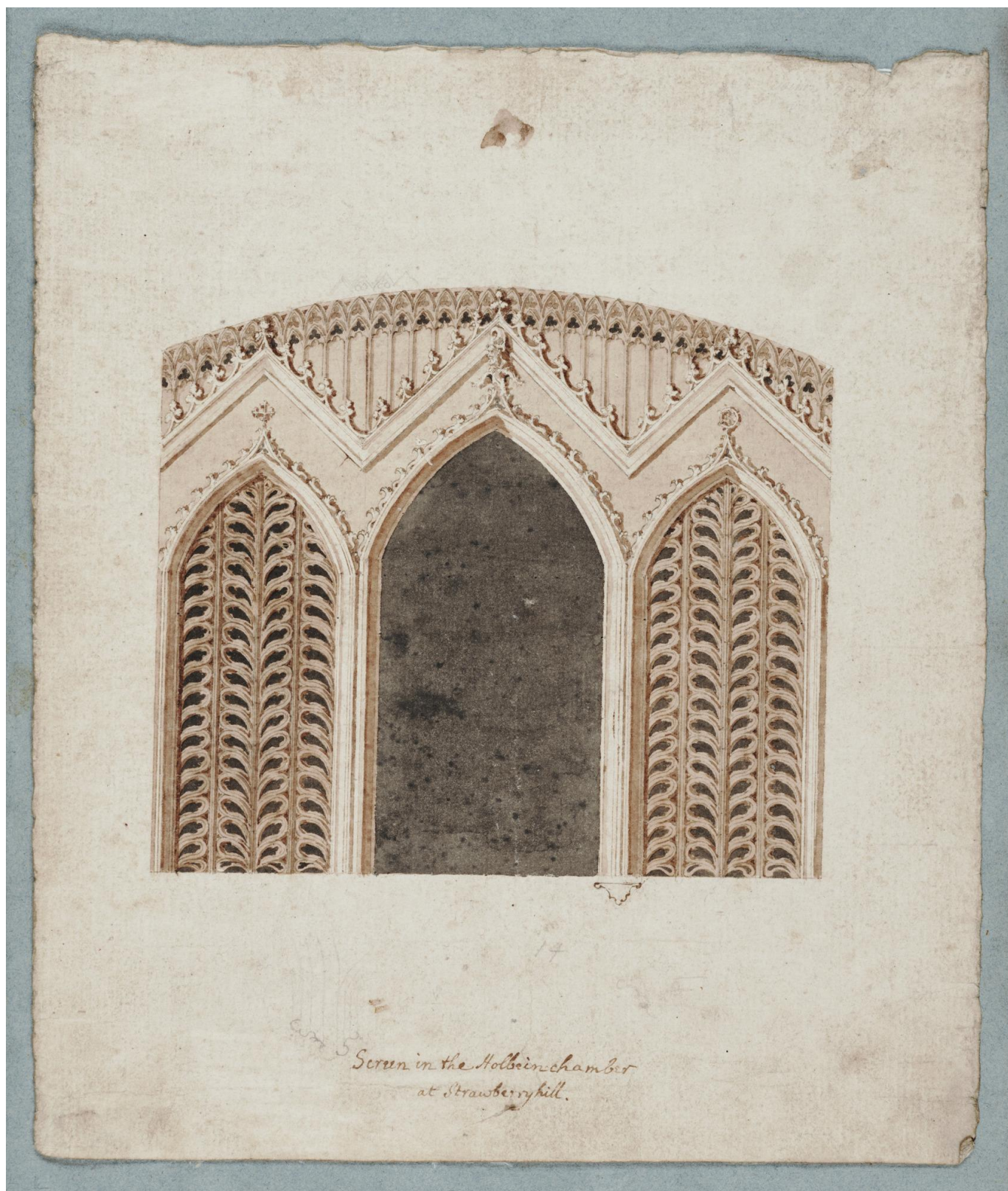


Caption: [Side elevation of a design (not executed) of a farm-house for Sr. Thomas Seabright at Beechwood in Hertfordshire]

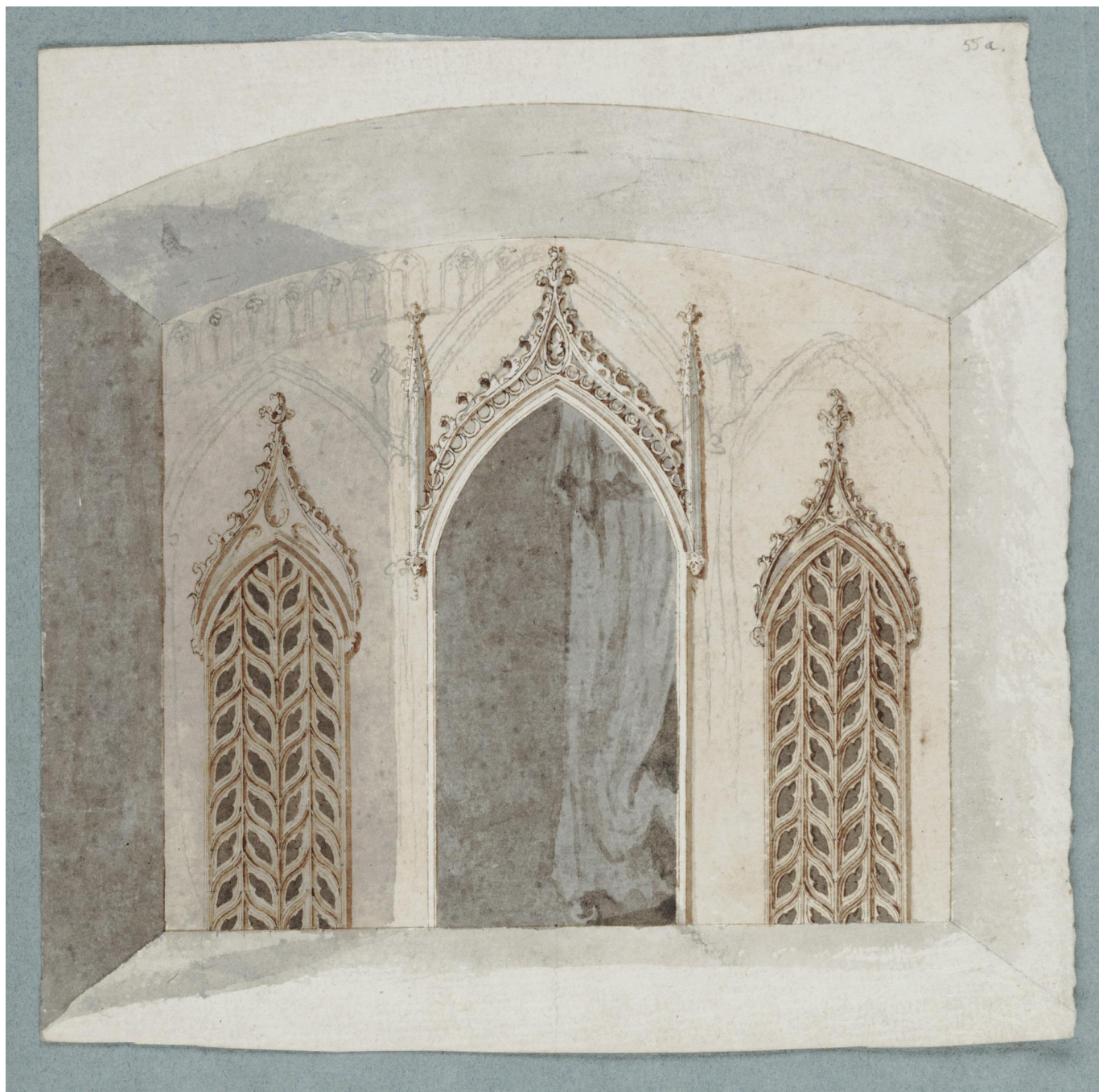


Caption: Screen in the Holbein Chamber at Strawberryhill [art original].

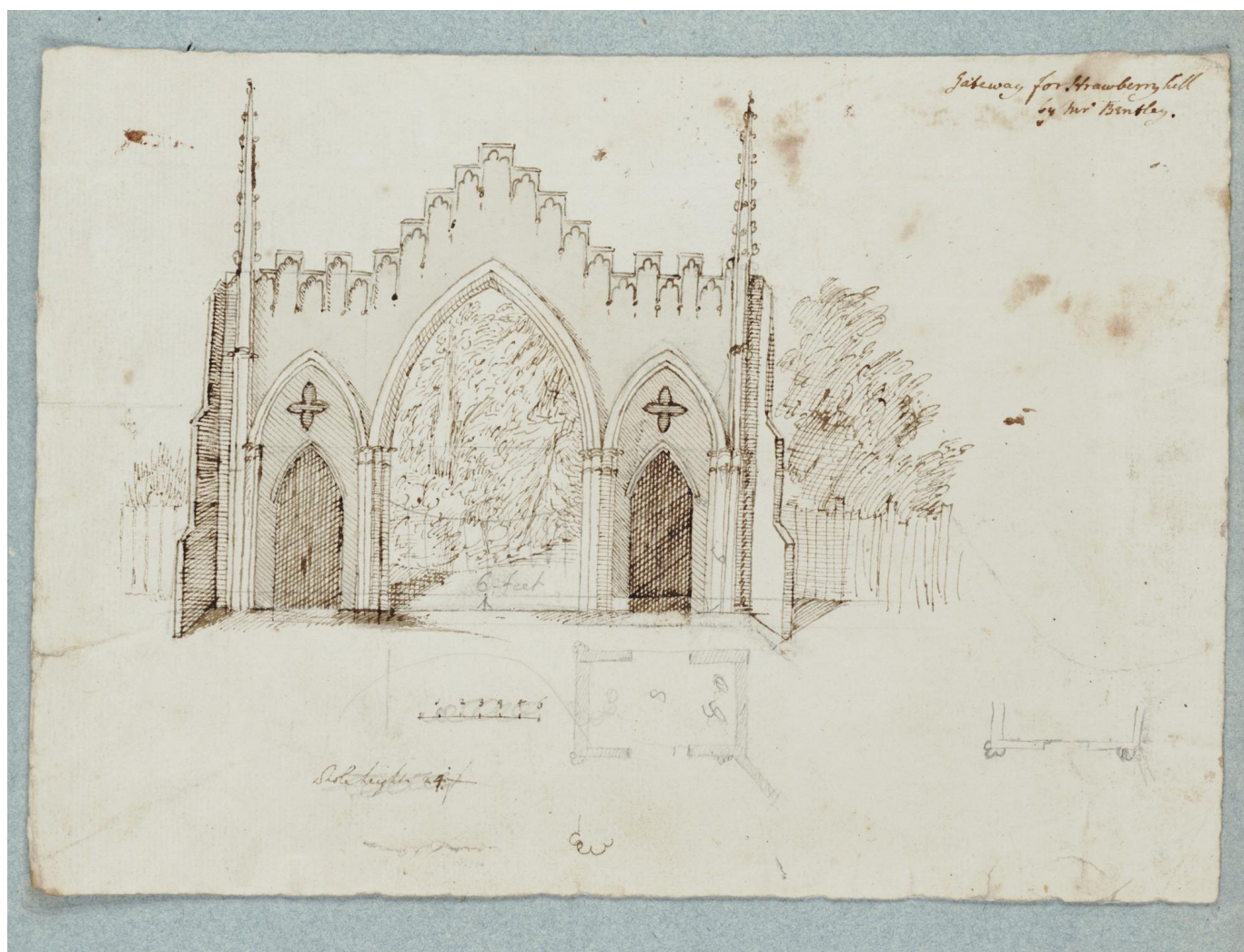


Caption: Sketch of the gallery at Strawberryhill [art original].

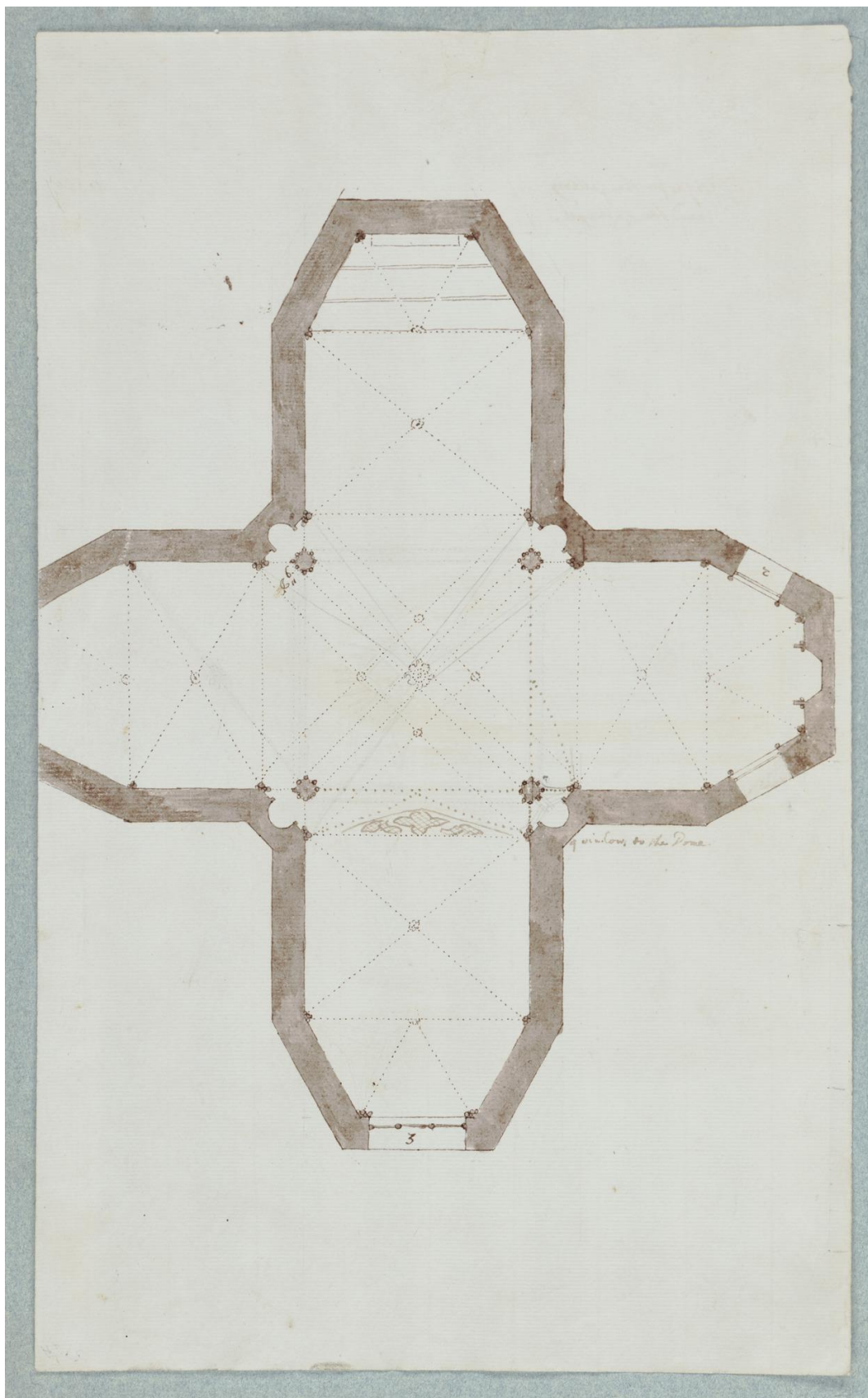


Sketch of the Gallery at Strawberryhill.
