I think you are wise to give up your projected edition of Walpole's Memoirs unless you could give up ten years to the work and have able assistants.

You ask where are the MSS now? They are where they have been since 1797, in the possession of the Earls Waldegrave. That is, ninety per cent of them are. Most of the rest, which got separated from the main lot at that time, are now here; a few important bits strayed to Holland House and are now owned by Lord Ilchester.
