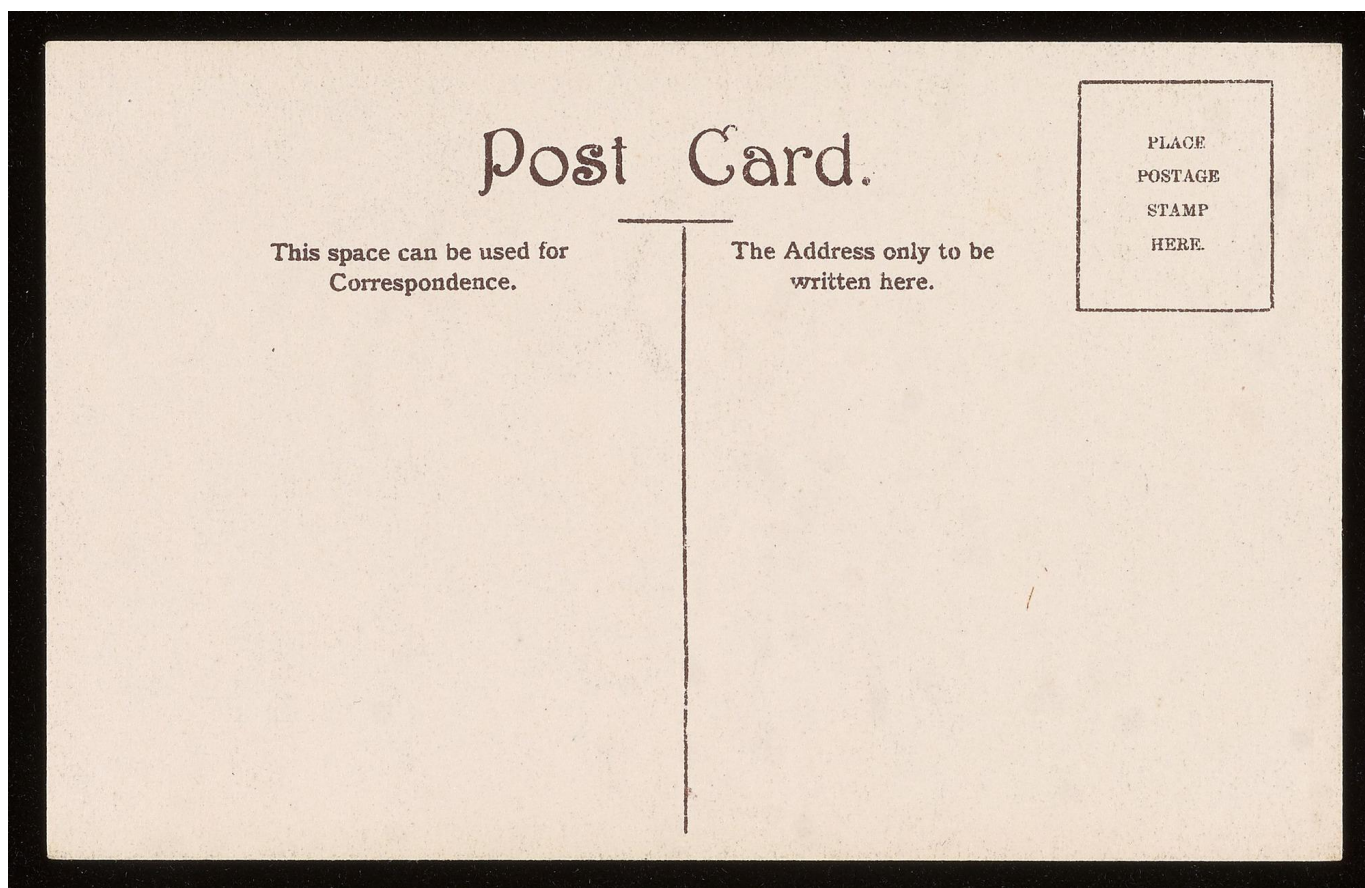


JOHN RUSKIN AT BRANTWOOD.

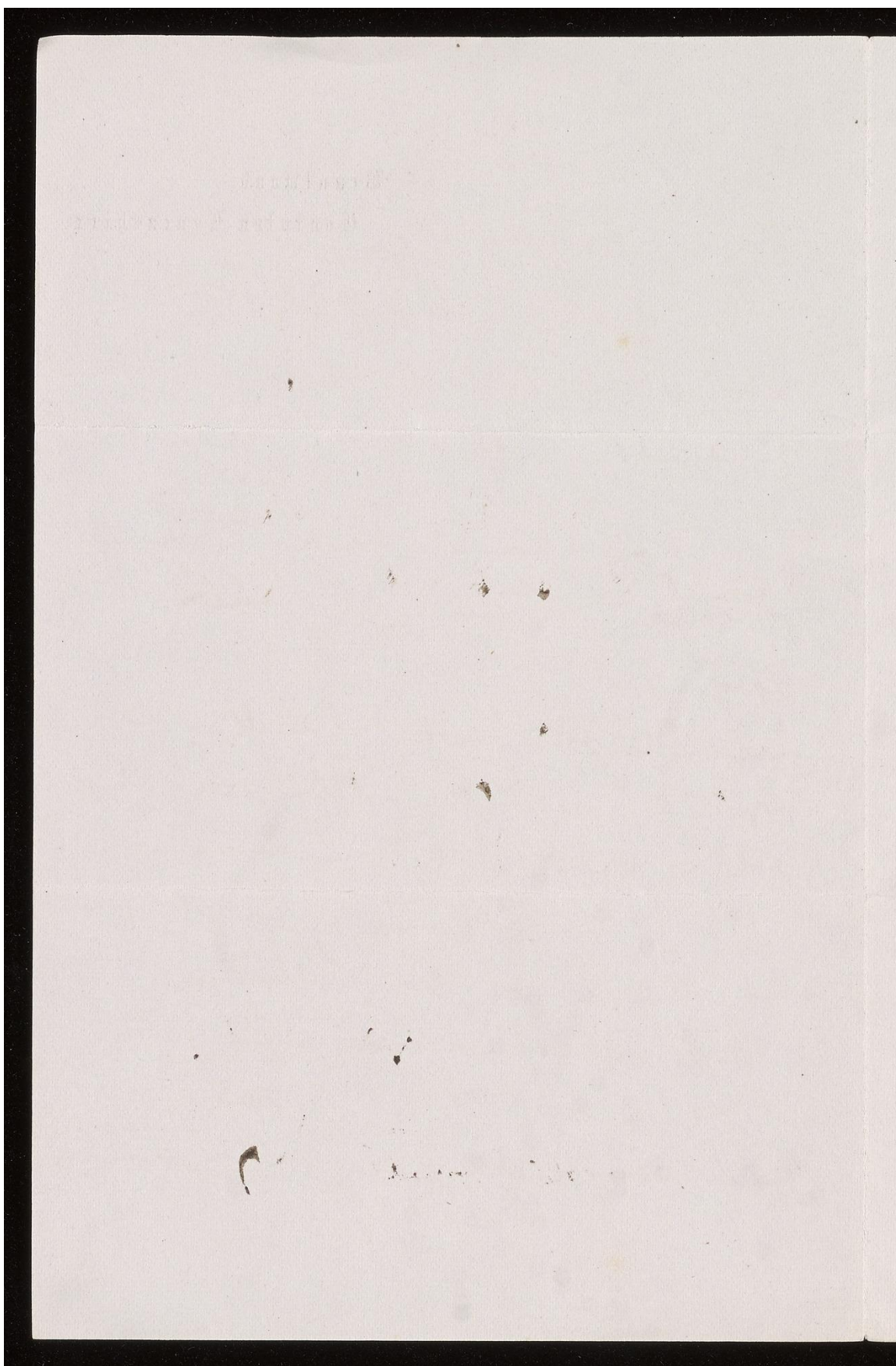
