Know All Men that the happy empire in honor of George Washington the first President of the United States by and with the advice and consent of the Senate do hereby certify that the said *EDWARD D. MANSFIELD* was duly appointed and sworn in as Adjutant General of the United States on the 20th day of July 1866. And that he has taken the oath of office and qualification and is now acting as such in and to the said office. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and the seal of the said office at the City of Washington this 30th day of July 1866.
