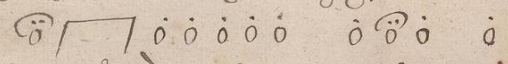

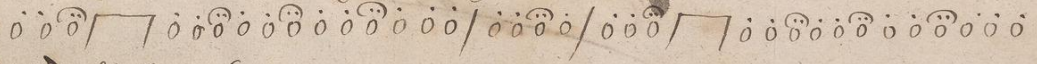

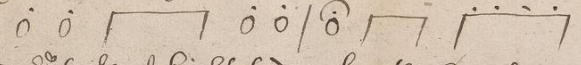

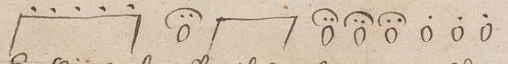
A Forgeat when the Hound hunt a right game.



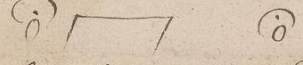
The double Forgeat.



The Strake of Light to draw from the Court.



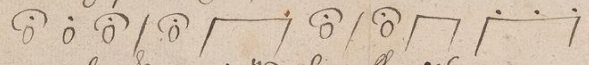
The Lutting of a stop if hee has recoverable.



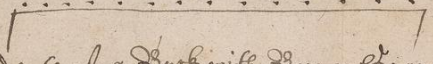

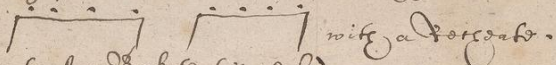
The Death of a stop in field or Court.



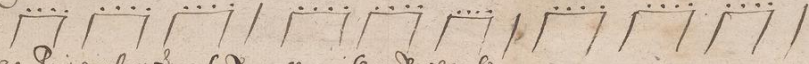
The Call for Reason in Parks or Forest.



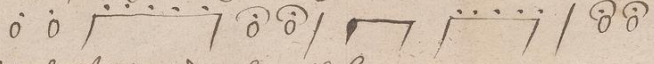
The Death of a Hunt with Fox or Grayhound.



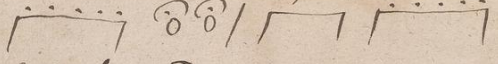
The Death of a Hunt that is chased.



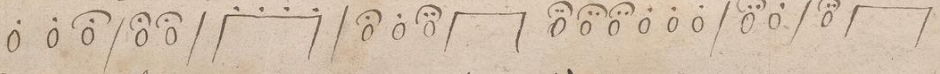
The Ring of a Hunt Royal with a Forgeat.
