I read you the Extract of an Advice I received yesterday from Carolina confirming the news of the Scotch having Quitted Larick. It was a great Chance I ever had this letter the ship being cast away that brought it.

I leave it to Mr. yare to Inform you that the Spanish Ambassador has his orders to be gone I am told hee has hired a ship in the River to carry him to Flanders & that hee designs to Embark about the 11 or 12 of this month. I am
