Hoopah the Raven at the bottom
 The Raven as a man, is holding the magic Salmon
 Taira, which bites out the raven's heart and he
 uncovers a Raven eye afterward.
 Above the Raven is the (Hoort) Bear with the
 Hunter (Howato) in his mouth, and his
 claws tearing open the hunter's breast.
 The upper figure is a Bear (Hoort), with two
 frogs, one of which he is eating.
 The three small figures surmounting all
 are the chief, in centre, and two friends,
 with the Taden skullish, or hats, &
 Cuamey on their heads.
