

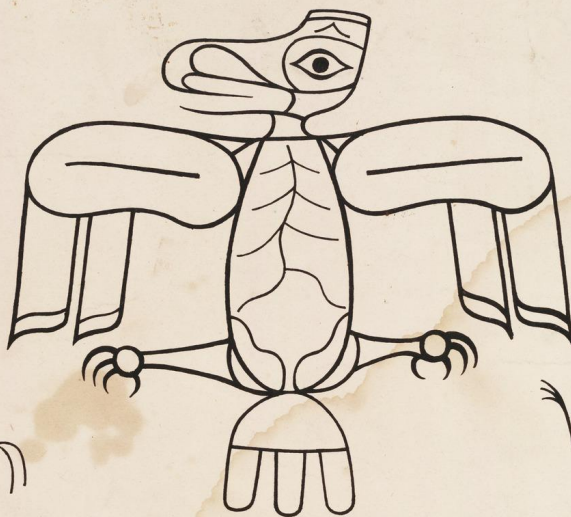

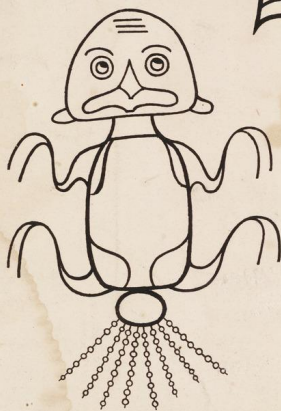
Tattoo Marks No 14. Skam-som.
