An Account of y^e Standard in Generall,
 The Standard is a Rich Embrodery of Gold & Silver, the Characters
 Upon the Green Ground Embroder'd with Gold, The Border vpon a Red
 Ground Intervoven wth Flowrings of Silver: The Middle part richly
 Embroder'd wth Gold vpon a Red Ground. The Characters wovon
 into y^e Ground. The length of y^e Standard from y^e point to y^e Staffe is
 12 Roman Palmes: the breadth of y^e whole, 8 Palmes, the breadth of y^e Green,
 One Palme & 2 Inches, The breadth of y^e Narrow Red border, 8 Inches, At y^e top
 of y^e Staffe is a Gult Ball, & 2 Rings vnder it, for 2 strings of Greene silk to
 run in, to keep the Standard Steady, & to Secure it against the Wind.
