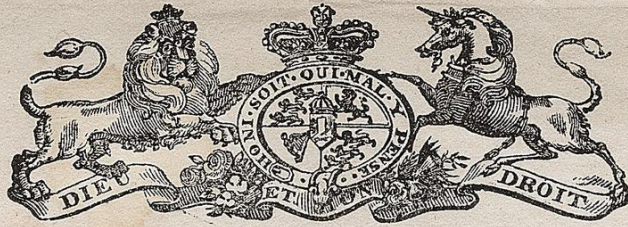

4 Geo. IV. Cap. 60,

Notice is hereby Given,
that Lotteries are about to Cease;
and that only Two more will be
allowed in this Kingdom, viz. one
on the 3^d of MAY next, and
another immediately after that
Day. When these Two are
drawn, all Lotteries must then
be discontinued

**BY ORDER
Of Government.**

The present Scheme, being the Last but One that will
ever be Drawn in England, contains SIX Prizes of £21,000,
besides other Capitals, the whole of which will be decided in
ONE DAY, 3^d MAY.
