Yes, we have had drought here, and quite a lot of crops were lost. Then, we did get some rain for a few days, but it is now sunny again. It is not quite as hot as it was.

I was surprised to hear that you had a skunk near you: I always imagined you only got them round out in the West. I have read, and heard a lot about them, but I never have had a personal encounter.

I can imagine Linda must have great fun in the water. How small children always love it.

I am just going over to Lugano to stay with Hilda and Perdita for ten days. Write to Kenwin because my letters will be forwarded, and I am not quite sure of my exact date of return. As you may imagine, I am looking forward very much to seeing them.
