

Notes re Cunard-White Star designs:

Item No.1:

Toilet Shelf: Used in proximity to Wash Basins to hold light toilet articles such as Shaving Brushes, Shaving Soap, Bottles, Razor etc.

General size and depth as old pattern - screwless method of fixing.

Item No.2:

Carafe Holder: Used in proximity to basin to carry Company's Glass Bottle for drinking purposes. Screwless fixing.

(Roanoid to obtain glassware from Cunard-White Star)

Item No.3:

Toilet Bottle Container: Used in Wash Basin recess of cabin to carry small toilet articles such as hair oil, nail varnish, lotions etc. Screwless fixing.

Item No.4:

Glass Holder: Used in proximity to basin to carry drinking glass. Screwless fixing.

(Roanoid to obtain glass ware from Cunard-White Star)

Item No.5:

Sponge Holder: Sometimes used for soap - used over wash basin and possibly over bath. Drainage holes considered necessary, must be of sufficient strength to withstand occasional pulling. Size approximately as model - 7" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Screwless fixing.

Item No.6:

Hat & Coat Hook: Length of top prong must remain as old pattern. Hook must be sufficiently strong to withstand full weight of passenger. Secret fixing.

Item No.7:

Berthlight: Position to be on bulkhead, centrally, behind head of bed, not in corner as old pattern. Fitting to be

designed to carry 40-watt lamp and the angle of light to be thrown on book for passenger's convenient reading in bed.

Item No.8:

Hand Grip: Used for W.C. Baths and Berths, either horizontally, vertically or diagonally. Screwless fixing.
As a rule W.C.grips are fitted diagonally,
Bath " " " horizontally
Berth " " " vertically

General length and projection as old pattern.

Item No.9:

Thermos Jug: Volume of liquid 1 pint. Design of Thermos interior can be new.
