RESOLUTIONS UPON THE DEATH OF MRS. P. H. MALORY.

For more than half a century Mrs. P. H. Malory has been a citizen of Belton, and for many years she has been an outstanding landmark in Belton Society. She was a person of puritanical type, sincere, straightforward and unswerving in her purpose, ever mindful of her duty to God and her fellowman, a citizen of the first rank, being always loyal to her church and community.

Mrs. Malory was admitted to membership in the Belton Chapter of the Women of the Ku Klux Klan as an honorary member on account of her advanced age, but on account of ill health she was not able to take active part in the programme of this organization, though she was very much interested in the organization and gave her enthusiastic support in all its work.

On Monday, July 13th, 1925, God, in his wisdom, saw fit to remove her from our midst and has taken her weary spirit to rest in peace with him.

Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Belton Chapter of the Women of the Ku Klux Klan that in the removal of Mrs. Malory from our midst we have lost a loyal member and an ardent supporter, belton a revered and respected citizen and her family a wise and beloved mother, and

Be It further resolved that we sympathize profoundly with the bereaved family in this hour of sadness and grief, and

Be It further resolved that a copy of this resolution be mailed to her family, and that a copy be given to the local press and that a copy be spread upon the minutes of this organization.
