J^rDublin Castle 18th March 1707.

We received Your Letter of the 10th inst. Signifying her Mat^{ty} Pleasure that the Dragoones & Horse formerly ordered to be sent into England should be dispatched away with all the expedition imaginable, We desire You will please to acquaint her Mat^{ty} that in this & all other things her Commands shall always meet with a most ready and exact obedience from Us; The Two Regiments of Dragoones are already shipped & the Horse which came to Towne but this night, shall be sent away without delay.

Maj^r Gen^{le} G^{ve} arrived here Yesterday in the Evening, but brought Us no Orders relating either to these Troopes or the Foot that are to be filled up, soe that Wee must expect them, (as you mention) by the next Paquets, but in case they should not be yet
